



The Youth Power



As the KCS President during its silver jubilee year, one of my goals was to reform the basic structure of KCS to make it relevant to modern times and to develop a young team to lead the organisation for the next 25 years. I had promised to myself that the future Presidents of KCS must be from the next generation and I must be the last President of the older generation. If I am asked to name one accomplishment of my presidency of which I am personally satisfied, I have no hesitation to say that the torch has been passed to a young team. I am proud and pleased to state that the new team who took charge on July 1, 2022 is relatively young and it is raring to go. The path has been cleared for them. The average age of the current GC is just 50 years. Just like the visionary men and women who were in their forties or fifties when they assembled on December 15 of the year 1996 to weave the warp and woof of Kerala Catholic Society, it is remarkable that after a quarter of century another group of successful men and women of around the same age group have taken over the reins to lead the society for the next 25 years. It is an epochal change indeed.

When the KCS was founded, the internet was in its nascent stage. Emails were not prevalent. Cell phones and social media were in the imagination of technological minds of that era. The Indian economy was just opening up with Maruthi 800 cars. The years of 2021 and 2022 are vastly different in style and substance from the days of 1996. Life has changed in profound ways. So it is imperative that any organisation worth its salt must listen to the clarion call of change, if not, the organisation is bound to wither and die.

Mr. Rajeev Bhargava, Professor Centre of Study of Developing Societies, put it succinctly. "Like individuals who constitute them, institutions also go to sleep. They suffer from lethargy and inertia. When that happens, they need to be reawakened and renewed, something impossible without self-reflection. From time to time, there should be collective deliberations about the purpose and importance of the practices of institutions."

We must examine if our society is sleeping. If so, how do we reawaken and renew ? It is a challenge and opportunity for the new leaders. I am of the opinion that our membership is strong financially and structurally. From my personal experience of the dialysis project, I can say with confidence that for a good cause, our members will cooperate wholeheartedly and donate generously. Therefore, the horizon of opportunities is wide open. It is for us to grasp and change. I am confident that the new office bearers will lead the KCS to a generational change by ushering in new programmes, projects and activities to attract the seemingly reluctant youth to join our society to make it more dynamic, energetic and glorious.

I wish the new team the very best and invoke special blessings of our Lord in their endeavours. "It is fascinating to think that the team now in charge will be around in 2046 when KCS celebrates its golden jubilee".
